

Gender Pay Gap Report 22/23

Difference in hourly rate

- Women's mean hourly rate is 13.6% lower than men's. In other words when comparing mean hourly rates, women earn 86p for every £1 that men earn.
- Women's median hourly rate is 24.1% lower than men's. In other words when comparing median hourly rates, women earn 76p for every £1 that men earn.
