

## Gender Pay Gap Report 20/21

## **Difference in hourly rate**

- Women's mean hourly rate is 0.5 higher than men's In other words when comparing mean hourly rates, women earn £1.01 for every £1 that men earn.
- Women's median hourly rate is 7.6% lower than men's In other words when comparing median hourly rates, women earn 92p for every £1 that men earn.
