## **Difference in hourly rate**

- Women's mean hourly rate is 4.4% lower than men's In other words when comparing mean hourly rates, women earn 96p for every £1 that men earn.
- Women's median hourly rate is 11.6% lower than men's In other words when comparing median hourly rates, women earn 88p for every £1 that men earn.
